



A **STRICT FIRE BAN** is in effect from December 1 to March 1, leading to the removal of firepits. For extensions, please visit www.rfs.nsw.gov.au/fire-information/fdr-and-tobans.

Due to current dry, hot and sometimes windy weather conditions, which have led to numerous recent fires in the area, there are currently **STRICT FIRE RESTRICTIONS** in place.

To prevent wildfires, please follow these rules, as a single spark can spread within seconds.

- Please never leave a fire unattended.
- Please always extinguish the fire before bedtime. Even on calm nights, winds can change rapidly, and sparks may ignite a fire.
- Please only use the provided fire pit in the designated fire pit area.
- Please never throw burning logs onto the surrounding grass.
- Please don't use open-flame devices outdoors, except for our provided BBQs.
- Please dispose of cigarette butts responsibly.
- Fire Extinguishers are supplied either in the kitchen or under the bathroom sink.
- If you need to empty the fire pit, hot tub firebox, or inside fireplace, please dispose of the ash in the metal bin behind your accommodation for proper disposal.
- Hot tub reheating is permitted, but please exercise caution. Alternatively, use the nearby bucket to empty out 25% of the water and re-fill the tub with very hot water.
- Please feel free to enjoy the indoor fireplace.
